



Dear Colleague,

Thank you for your interest in a microgrant to start, develop, or resource an initiative that focuses on a social justice theme, addresses a community need, or supports a specific group in need. Please find below the grant criteria. As the budget is limited, the maximum that can be applied for over a calendar year is £500.

Criteria for JPIC grants

1. To start or develop an activity or initiative that incorporates one or more of **The Marks of Mission**: 3,4,5 as shown below.

The Five Marks of Mission

- **1. Tell:** To proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom.
- **2. Teach:** To teach, baptize, and nurture new believers.
- **3. Tend:** To respond to human need by loving service.
- **4. Transform:** To transform unjust structures of society, to challenge violence of every kind and pursue peace and reconciliation.
- **5. Treasure:** To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation, and sustain and renew the life of the earth.

2. The parish must comply with the Participation Between Parishes and the Diocese Policy.

3. The dates for the project must be realistic.

4. Applicant must explain expected outcomes and the fruitfulness anticipated from the project.

5. Leaders must be willing to share learning, both positive and negative with the wider church, and so contribute to mission of the whole Diocese. Please note that we will not be able to consider any future Mission Department grants' applications until feedback for previously approved grant has been submitted.

6. The parish applying for the grant must show the willingness to engage with the JPIC Team. The project can be discussed with the Natalie Walters (Head of JPIC) before the application.

7. The form must be discussed with and approved by the Incumbent

8. The money should be paid into an organisation bank account.

9. The grant does not cover church hire costs, staffing costs, or changes to the internal structured of the building.
