Diocesan Council of Trustees: Nominations

House of Laity Only

1. Following a nominations process to elect members of Synod to the Diocesan Council of Trustees (DCT), provision is made for up to six lay persons, with up-to-date financial or other relevant expertise, to be nominated to the DCT and formally elected by the House of Laity of Synod.
2. There are four lay people who are already serving as chair of the Diocesan Advisory Committee, and chairs of sub-committees of the DCT. At the start of this new triennium it is necessary that these four people are elected to the DCT by the House of Laity.
3. The Chairs formally nominated are:

Nicholas Burt Chair of the Policy & Finance Committee

Michael Hartley Chair of the Audit & Governance Committee

Philip Fletcher Chair of the Diocesan Advisory Committee

Andrew McMurtrie Chair of the Investment Committee

4. The nominees, who will take up 4 of the 6 specialist lay places, have previously been members of the DCT. Their service on the DCT will conclude with the end of the current triennium, or if they cease to be chair of their respective committees.
