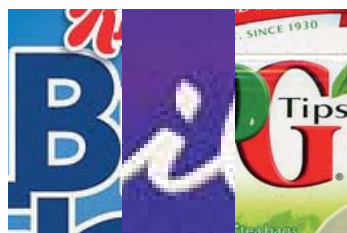

Competition

Identify as many different things as possible in the course of a day that you could swap for a currently available Fairtrade variety.

How it works

A point will be given for each different individual item that could be swapped for a Fairtrade Product.

Each type of item will only be counted once.

Points will not be given for different brands of the same kind of product.

The day can be a fictional day and it is not necessary to have actually made the swaps, but in order to show that it would be possible to make these swaps in the course of a day you should give times and an explanation for the swaps e.g. 7.00am swapped my breakfast Coffee for a Fairtrade Coffee.

Prizes will go to the person in each of the age categories below that comes up with the highest number of swaps

0 – 11

11 – 20

20+

In the event of a tie our judges will use the tie break question to decide on a winner.
