Our Mission Action Plan has four priorities: visibility, growing our spiritual lives together, children and young people, loving service in the community. The Parish Support Fund enables us to have a fulltime stipendiary Team Rector/Vicar and this has allowed the parish to grow and develop hugely. Our congregation has doubled in the last three years and our junior church has grown from 7 to 30/40 in the same period.

From the Churchwardens

2017 is an exciting year for St Luke's with the arrival of Lorenzo Fernandez-Vicente on 5th April as our new vicar. He will arrive at a church that is thriving in so many ways thanks to the amazing support of our congregation and its generosity in all that it does and gives. He will have a very strong foundation to build on.

We need St Luke's to be in a strong financial position to enable him to take us forward with confidence.

If you look across at our budget for 2017 for St Luke's (excluding the Hall) you will quickly see that we are forecasting a deficit of £20,700. The PCC believes fundamentally that the church and hall should each be self-sufficient. This might not be the case for the church without additional support.

Why has this come about? The main reason is that our voluntary Planned Giving has declined in recent years. Several generous members of the congregation have moved away and sadly we have lost some too. Also, for a variety of reasons, many new members of the congregation have not yet set up a standing order as part of the Planned Giving scheme.

So for our annual Stewardship Campaign we are appealing to you to please consider the following:

- For those of you in the congregation, but not already in Planned Giving, to please join it and take out a standing order and give at least £10 a month to support the work of your church and its mission.
- For those of you already in Planned Giving, to increase your giving by at least £10 a month maintaining your commitment to St Luke's work and mission.

'At the heart of the local community serving the wider community' is our strapline and our mission at St Luke's. On the back page you can find out more about the Parish Support Fund to which so much of our money rightly goes. The support of 30 charities is also a key part of our mission.
