


#### Churchwardens


- We are aware of the additional pressures for wardens over this last year





- Employment in times of COVID-19
  - Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme
    - Furlough
    - · Extended to end of April 2021
    - · Budget next week further extension, or not?
  - · Extension of Carry Forward of annual leave
    - Updated Working Time Regulations allow for up to 4 weeks untaken annual leave to be carried forward for coronavirus related reasons and taken over the next two years.



PCC secretaries and parish administrators play a pivotal role


Each parish makes a pledge and the Parish Support Fund (PSF) resources the mission and ministry across the Diocese


In 2021 the PSF pack will be sent digitally to PCC secretaries (and Incumbents) at the beginning of July
