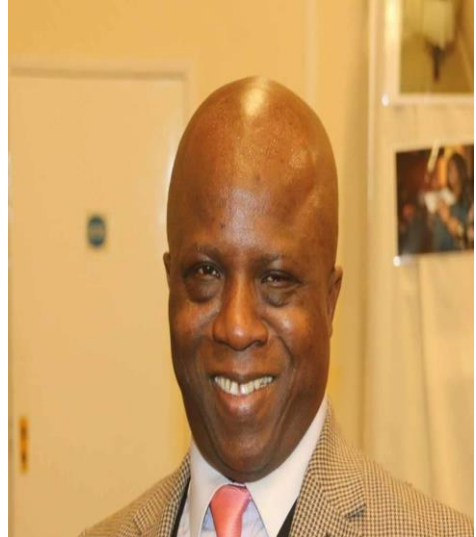

Decision to stand for Synod
