11.43 **Bishop**

Here Jesus turns our lives around, helping us to let go of sin so that we can take hold of his risen life.

As children of God, we have a new dignity and God calls us to live life to the full.

12.00 Core team will have already handed out 40 cups. They are invited to fill the font/baptism pool with water from a bucket on stage.

Congregational leader:

While we sing this prayer of praise over the water, we invite those of you who have been given a cup to come and top up the font with their water. Our singers and signers are going to lead us:

12.17 Congregational leader:

Whilst our candidates and Bishop get changed, could you give me a wave if you have been baptised or Christened as a baby?

We now want to remind you of your baptism and sprinkle you with water. Who made a bundle of rosemary? This can be dipped in water and used to sprinkle water. This is called asperging. If you have made a rosemary, please come forward and collect a cup of water from the pool, to help our team asperge the congregation, reminding us all of baptism?

Commission

Congregational leader:

Whilst they are doing that, we are going to sing a couple of songs that remind us of the importance of belonging in God's family, alongside parents, godparents, brothers and sisters. We're also going to sing about belonging to the Church, both our local church and the world wide church. Some of us did prayer activities that helped us think about Christians around the world.

12.27 **Bishop:**
