



DIOCESAN SYNOD

Co-Options

House of Laity Only

1. The House of Laity are permitted to co-opt up to five members to the Diocesan Synod.
2. The vice-chair of the Diocesan Board of Finance (DCT) and Chairs of the Diocesan Council of Trustees' sub-committees are nominated and co-opted to the Diocesan Synod if they have not been formally elected previously.
3. This ensures that Diocesan Synod representation is clearly embedded within the Diocesan Governance Structures.
4. Formal nominees for co-option are:

David Beamish Vice-Chair of the Diocesan Board of Finance (DCT)

Nicholas Burt Chair of the Policy & Finance Committee

5. These nominees have previously been members of the DCT and of the Diocesan Synod. Their service on the Diocesan Synod will conclude with the end of the current triennium, or if they cease to be chair of their respective committees.
