



## Directions to St Peter's, Battersea

### By Rail

- The closest station is Clapham Junction which is served by:
  - South Western Railway - from London Waterloo, Richmond, Kingston, and Wimbledon
  - Southern - from Croydon, Reigate, and Sutton
  - The London Overground - from Rotherhithe and Denmark Hill
- Those travelling from the Woolwich Episcopal Area (Thamesmead, Lewisham, Eltham, etc.) will have to take a Southeastern service to Waterloo East, and change to a South Western Railway service from Waterloo to Clapham Junction - these depart every few minutes
- From Clapham Junction:
  - Use the Grant Road Exit (by platforms 1 & 2)
  - Turn Left onto Grant Road, follow it to the junction with Plough Road
  - Turn Right onto Plough Road
  - The Church on the right immediately after Fowler Close
  - The journey should take about fifteen minutes

### By Bus

- The closest bus stop is Wallis Close, about two minutes away, which is served by the 170, 295, & C3
- Clapham Junction Station is served by the 49, 170, 319, 344, 345, 37, 87, 156, 337, 35, 77, 219, G1, & C3
- The directions from Clapham Junction bus stop are the same as for the train

## By Road

- St Peter's Church does not offer parking facilities
- Free parking can be found on the streets around the Winstanley Estate, however this cannot be guaranteed
- Parking spaces can be booked for the day (for about £10) at:
