

DIOCESAN SYNOD

Co-Options to Diocesan Synod House of Laity Only

The Chair of the House of Laity to move that:

"The House of Laity approve the co-option of Sarah Docx, Nicholas Burt, and Alan Saunders to the Diocesan Synod with immediate effect"

- 1. The House of Laity are permitted to co-opt up to five members to the Diocesan Synod.
- 2. The vice-chair of the Diocesan Board of Finance (DCT) and Chairs of the Diocesan Council of Trustees' sub-committees are nominated and co-opted to the Diocesan Synod if they have not been formally elected to Diocesan Synod. This ensures that Diocesan Synod representation is clearly embedded within the Diocesan Governance structures at all levels.
- 3. Formal nominees for co-option to Diocesan Synod are:

Sarah Docx Vice-Chair of the Diocesan Board of Finance (DCT)

Nicholas Burt Chair of the Policy & Finance Committee

Alan Saunders Chair of the Investment Committee

4. These nominees have previously been members of the DCT and of the Diocesan Synod. Their service on the Diocesan Synod will conclude with the end of the current triennium, or if they cease to be chair of their respective committees.
