Church Accessibility Training

A 2 - 2.5hrs interactive training session delivered in your church by a professional therapist.



Leaders Accessibility Training

A 2 - 2.5hrs training session for clergy and church leaders, hosted centrally within the diocese.



In Person Accessibility Award

A professional therapist visits your church to carry out a detailed accessibility audit, including observation of a Sunday service and ministry activities.



Remote Accessibility Award

A flexible first step towards accessibility. We can provide a remote accessibility review conducted via video call with a professional therapist.

Free Training Available

We do not want cost to be a barrier to churches beginning their accessibility journey.

Through our partnership with the Church of England, this support is currently available free of charge to participating churches for a limited time.
